The meeting commenced with the CEO and the two Directors extending their congratulations to Dr. T. D. Sairam on his appointment as Dean - Internships & Placements for the DFT Group of Institutions. The CEO outlined the responsibilities and expectations associated with this new role.

Key Decisions and Action Points:

1. Dr. Sairam will conduct a diagnostic test for all final-year students to identify top performers and those requiring additional support.
2. High-performing students will undergo specialised grooming to enhance their chances of securing high-paying placements.
3. Students identified as needing improvement will be offered remedial courses during the 7th term to enhance their placement readiness.
4. Dr. Sairam will organise a demonstration of the Superset platform for all Placement Officers. All final-year students will be required to subscribe to the platform and complete a minimum of five assignments.
5. A comprehensive placement brochure featuring eligible students from all DFT colleges will be compiled under Dr. Sairam's supervision.

6. Placement Officers will ensure that students create LinkedIn profiles and actively connect with their professors and relevant industry professionals.
7. The successful 'Walk With HR' initiative by CKEC may be adopted by other institutions. Principals are encouraged to incorporate proven best practices from within the group and from leading peer institutions.
8. Principals are advised to arrange grooming sessions for students in collaboration with professional salons (e.g., Green Trends), focusing on hair styling and personal appearance.
9. Principals will facilitate the procurement of blazers for all final-year students by collecting the required funds from them.

10. Principals are requested to identify faculty members from English, Humanities, and Management departments for training in soft skills instruction.
11. The CEO set a goal of achieving a 25% increase in the average salary package for 2025-26, compared to the 2024-25 academic year.

The meeting concluded with a call for collective effort and timely execution of the above action points to enhance the placement outcomes of the DFT Group.
